<p>Verbal/Linguistic</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Write an alternate ending for the novel. *Create an alternate title for this novel --Explain why you choose this title. *Prepare five (5) interview questions for the author/main character. 	<p>Musical/Rhythmic</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Create a song or rap that reflects the main character or a theme from the novel. *Select a song from today that would serve as a theme song for the novel. Explain why this song is a perfect theme song. *Write a poem based on the characters, setting and/or events in the novel.
<p>Visual/Spatial</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Create a collage to depict the novel you read. *Create a comic strip based on a scene/event from the novel. * Using a shoebox create a diorama (a model representing a scene with three-dimensional figures). 	<p>Logical/Mathematical</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Create a timeline noting important events from the story. *Compare/Contrast two characters or two of the scenes from the book. *Create mathematical word problems using the names of the characters, the setting or events from the novel.
