**School Uniform Policy**

<b>Shirts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shirts must be plain solid navy or solid white collared or button-down shirts, long or short sleeved.</li> <li>• Logos, print or embellishments are <u>not permitted</u>.</li> <li>• White or navy undershirts may be worn underneath uniform shirts as long as they are plain without visible logos.</li> </ul>
<b>Pants</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Black, Khaki or navy blue shorts, skirts or pants made of chino or cotton twill material must be worn.</li> <li>• Cords are <u>not allowed</u>.</li> <li>• Black, Khaki or navy denim pants are <u>not allowed</u>.</li> <li>• Shorts and skirts must be knee length.</li> <li>• Skinny pants, jeggings and leggings are <u>not permitted</u>.</li> </ul>
<b>Shoes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sneakers with rubber soles, no more than ankle height must be worn.</li> <li>• Boots, heels, wedges, flats and sandals are <u>not permitted</u>. Sneakers must remain fastened with ties or Velcro.</li> <li>• Light up shoes are <u>not permitted</u>.</li> <li>• Left and right shoes must match - swapping a shoes with another student is <u>not permitted</u>.</li> <li>• Students are <u>not permitted</u> to carry or change into extra shoes during the school day.</li> </ul>
<b>Socks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plain white or plain black socks must be worn; no visible logos or print.</li> <li>• Girls may wear plain white, black or navy tights, or flesh-tone hose.</li> </ul>
<b>Sweaters/Sweatshirts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only plain, solid navy or solid white pullover sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn. The only exceptions are school purchased t-shirts, sweatshirts, hoodies or full zip-up hoodies.</li> <li>• Sweaters/sweatshirts with embellishments are not permitted.</li> <li>• Team t-shirts, IDMS t-shirts, IDMS sweatshirts, IDMS hoodies or IDMS full zip-up hoodies purchased through the school can be worn any day with uniform pants.</li> <li>• Jackets are permitted during class change only, regardless of their color.</li> <li>• Jackets and sweatshirts are not allowed to be worn around the waist.</li> </ul>
<b>Misc.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hats may be worn to and from school. Upon arrival students need to put them away in their lockers.</li> <li>• No headgear of any kind will be allowed during school hours.</li> <li>• Certain exceptions may be considered by administration.</li> <li>• Shirts will be tucked at all times of the school day.</li> <li>• Students must wear brown or black belts if pants/skirts/shorts have belt loops. Sagging is not authorized.</li> <li>• Items of fad nature, (i.e.: large headbands, bandanas, bows, etc.) will not be allowed during school hours. These items are left to the discretion of administration. Headbands should be one inch or smaller in navy, white or black. Visible jewelry is limited to watches and/or stud earrings only.</li> </ul>
<b>Religious Accommodations</b> <i>CCS Update 09/24/2019</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All Cumberland County Schools will make any necessary religious accommodations for any type of headgear or head coverings otherwise restricted or prohibited under existing individual school dress codes.</li> </ul>
<b>Suspension Policy</b> <i>CCS Update 09/24/2019</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No student shall receive Out of School Suspension based solely upon violation of an existing individual school dress code.</li> </ul>
